Thinking Outside the Bottle

Interesting Beer Facts

You should always store bottled beer upright, not on its side. This minimizes oxidation and contamination from the cap.

Bottled beer is pasteurized. Keg beer is not. That's why it's critical for kegs to stay cold (3 deg C. or 38 deg F.) As the temperature rises, the CO2 gas expands (causing foamy beer) and dormant bacteria may become active and ruin the keg.

The type of water used for brewing makes a difference. The best ales are produced with hard water (with more natural salts like calcium) while soft water is better for lagers.

Before the 1400's ales were flavoured with herbs like rosemary and thyme. Hops were first introduced to preserve beer but are now a desirable flavour.

Dogfish Head (a US Microbrewery) brews a MidasTouch Golden Elixir which is made from a 2700 year old beer recipe that was found in a Royal tomb in Turkey.

The tomb is believed to be the burial place of the legendary King Midas.
